




























<p><b>Year 1/2</b> <b>Autumn Term</b></p> <p><b>Fairy Tales and Castles</b></p> 	<p><b>MATHS</b></p> <p>In maths we will count, read, order, compare and write numbers to 20 and to 100 in numerals and words. We will identify the value of digits in a number and use place value and number facts to solve problems. We will develop our addition and subtraction skills and begin multiplication. We will identify and sort common 2D and 3D shapes. We will also use money to make amounts and work out change.</p> 	<p><b>ENGLISH</b></p> <p>This term we will use stories based on Fairy Tales to develop our story-telling, writing and grammar skills. We will write character descriptions, posters and stories. We will have daily phonics and spelling sessions to practise our sounding out, blending and key words as well as improving handwriting.</p> 	
<p><b>SCIENCE</b></p> <p>We will learn about recycling and what happens to rubbish as well as learning how to look after our environment. We will classify and sort rubbish according to materials and their properties. We will also look at seasonal changes of Autumn into Winter.</p> 	<p><b>HISTORY</b></p> <p>We will learn about castles, their uses, development over time, who lived in them and entertainment.</p> 	<p><b>GEOGRAPHY</b></p> <p>We will learn the names of the oceans of the world. We will look at famous castles in each of the countries of the UK, also naming capitals of each of these countries and locating them on a map of the UK.</p> 	<p><b>COMPUTING</b></p> <p>We will learn to find and print pictures to use on recycling posters.</p> 
<p><b>ART &amp; DESIGN</b></p> <p>We will make recycled art using different materials to make collages, sculptures and models.</p> 	<p><b>DESIGN &amp; TECHNOLOGY</b></p> <p>We will make recycled paper and castle drawbridges.</p> 	<p><b>PE</b></p> <p>We will have P.E sessions every Tuesday and Thursday, focusing on applying movement skills, balance and agility to our activities. We will participate in team games and develop simple tactics in football.</p> 	<p><b>MUSIC</b></p> <p>We will compose simple patterns using body percussion and instruments to represent characters from stories. We will investigate tone, pitch, speed and volume. We will also learn songs for Christmas.</p> 
<p><b>RE</b></p> <p>We look at belonging and what that means in our families, school, church and community. We will introduce the Hindu faith and look at Diwali as well as the Christian Nativity Story at Christmas.</p> 	<p><b>PSHE</b></p> <p>In class we will be working on joining in well, taking turns and sharing with others. We will think about friendship and community.</p> 	<p><b>FRENCH</b></p> <p>The children have weekly French sessions with Madam Barnes and are learning a variety of words and phrases, exploring the language through stories.</p> 	<p><b>HOMEWORK</b></p> <p>Please read with your child at home and record their reading in their diaries as they are rewarded with dojo points for reading at least three times in a week. Please use key word lists in reading diaries to help learn Y1 and Y2 key words. Y2 children will also be given some maths or literacy homework on a Thursday to be handed in the following Thursday.</p>
