Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to update you on some changes to our end of year reports this academic year.

At Gilthill, we place great value on strong and open communication with parents and carers, and we are committed to ensuring you feel informed and involved in your child's learning journey. Throughout the year, we offer a range of opportunities to support this, including three parents' evenings, our end of year written report, and regular communication via Class Dojo. Dojo allows parents to message teachers directly and keeps you up to date through class and whole school stories. We also hold Open Classroom events and share monthly newsletters to help keep families informed about school life.

As you may know, Gilthill is part of the East Midlands Education Trust (EMET). As a Trust, schools have been working closely together to create a more concise and aligned end of year report format across our primary schools. This new format has been carefully designed to ensure it continues to provide all the key information you need, while being clear and easy to read.

The report will continue to summarise your child's school year, including academic information, attendance and effort. In addition, it will include a more concise and personalised comment from your child's class teacher, celebrating their achievements and personal attributes. All EMET primary schools in the local area will be using this updated report format.

As Headteacher, I will also be writing a summary letter for each class, celebrating the year, key experiences and collective achievements. This class letter will help capture the wider picture of the year and will accompany your child's individual end of year report.

Alongside these, you will also receive statutory end of year information, where applicable, including:

- End of Key Stage 2 assessment outcomes (Year 6)
- Phonics Screening Check results (Year 1)
- Multiplication Tables Check results (Year 4)
- EYFS end of year outcomes

Together, these documents are intended to give you a clear, balanced and informative overview of your child's progress, achievements and experiences across the year.

As shared previously, we will also be offering a Summer Term parents' evening, which will be optional. If you feel you would like to meet with your child's class teacher at this stage of the year, you are very welcome to do so. The booking link will be sent out tomorrow. However, you may feel that a meeting is not necessary, and that is absolutely fine too.

Your child's end of year report will be emailed to you in the penultimate week of the summer term, and during the final week of term, children will be bringing home their work from across the year to share with you.
