Summer Term 2024/25

Our topics are: **SPACE & VICTORIANS**



First, we will learn about gravity and understand the movement of the Earth and the moon. We will then explore forces, movements and magnets in Summer 2.



ART & DESIGN

Our focus is printing and textiles, and we will take inspiration from a space artist called Margaret Nazon to produce a space-inspired artwork using printing and textile techniques.





RE We will be delving into the meaning of worship and what it means to follow a

faith.

We will look at Islam, Hinduism, and Christianity, exploring their belief systems, places of worship, and their views on charity and generosity. We will consider how people express their beliefs through prayer, action, acts of kindness and compassion in the world around them.



MATHS

Fractions

Position and direction Decimals, negative numbers, converting units and volume.

Shape, space and measure. Recapping KS2 maths concepts.

We are focusing on applying our maths to problem

solving and reasoning. We are also working on our arithmetic, building on concepts learnt across KS2.

HISTORY

We will research explorers through time - Leif Eriksson, Columbus, Cook, Amundsen, Earhart, Hillary and Armstrong - and look at how their discoveries changed the world.



Moving Toys -We will design and make battery operate moon buggies. (Mechanisms).






