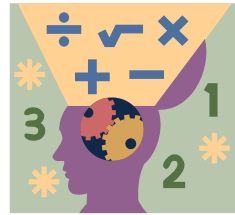


Welcome to Year 6

We are focusing on applying our maths to problem solving and reasoning. We are also working on our arithmetic, building on concepts learnt across KS2. Themed maths after SATs week.

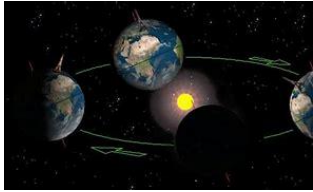
ENGLISH



Pandora Discovered- Non-chronological report, diary entry, setting description.
Wild Boy- character descriptions, narrative, newspaper
Space Exploration- biography
Children will be looking at sentence types and punctuation and using a range of these in their writing. They will be focussing on editing and publishing their work.
Whole class reading and spelling, punctuation and grammar sessions weekly.

SCIENCE

We will learn about and understand the Earth's movement in Space.
We will explore forces, movements and magnets.



HISTORY

Space Exploration

We will learn about the Space race – significance of first man on the moon.
We will research explorers through time - Leif Eriksson, Columbus, Cook, Amundsen, Earhart, Hillary, Armstrong.

Victorians

In Summer 2, we will start an in-depth study of the Victorians, delving into the industrial revolution, societal changes and the legacy of the era.

GEOGRAPHY



Digital/computer mapping of the Earth. Study of world's climate zones and biomes and ocean currents.
We will focus on temperate deciduous forest, Taiga, Grassland and marine biomes and also recap and deepen other biomes studied across KS2.

COMPUTING



3D Modelling. Design and model a planet or space craft using 3D modelling software.

We will also be continuing with our coding.

ART & DESIGN

To create art using textiles.
Explore how tone, pattern and shape can be used.
Demonstrate experience in a range of printing techniques.
Use methods carefully and make decisions about effectiveness of printing.

DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY

Moving Toys -We will design and make battery operate moon buggies. (Mechanisms).
